5)	Connect how the Bolsheviks broke with the socialist ideas of Karl Marx (1818-1883) and the working class to spearhead revolutionary change in Russia and form a new government that included an elite cadre of leaders needed to lead the revolution .
6)	Analyze the reasons why the call of, "Peace, Bread, and Land," by Bolshevik leader Vladimir Lennon (1870-1924) during World War I was answered by many Russians who flocked to his side to join his grass-roots organization and work to overthrow the provisional Russian government.

7) Explain what happened during the October Revolution in Russia in 1917.
8) Evaluate how the Bolsheviks lost the vote for the Constituent Assembly but still managed to grab power over the Russian people in January 1918.
9) Clarify what the Bolsheviks did to anybody who opposed them.
10) Analyze the reasons why Vladimir Lennon and the Bolsheviks accepted the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk in 1918 even though Russia ceded its western holdings to Germany .
11) Evaluate why the Communist International (1919-1943) spearheaded by the Bolsheviks aimed to promote and control the rise of Communist parties elsewhere around the world.
12) Analyze the reasons why YOU think the Russian Civil War (1918-1922) broke out in Russia .
13) Describe how the Bolsheviks took advantage of the divisions in ideological thought by confusing loyalties in order to weaken the other political parties .
14) Analyze the reasons why the White Movement was defeated by the Red Army .

15) Evaluate the type of Communist society that the Bolsheviks established in Russia .
