- 8) Analyze how the **Egyptian god Amun-Ra**, along with the advancements of the **Middle Kingdom** (2030 BCE to 1650 BCE), changed the religious structure of **Egypt**.

- 9) How did **Egyptian pharaohs Akhenaten** (1380-1334 BCE) and **Tutankhamen** (1341-1323 BCE) throw light upon **monotheism** in the **New Kingdom** (1550-1077 BCE) of **Egypt**?

- 10) Rationalize how the **Egyptian pharaoh King Tut (Tutankhamen)** (1341-1323 BCE) became so famous throughout the world even though he died at such a young age.
